What should I expect during an assessment?

 Initial Screening (optional): A focused session to identify key symptoms and determine if a comprehensive assessment is recommended.

Comprehensive screening includes:

- Clinical Interview: A detailed discussion about your history, symptoms, and any difficulties experienced in daily life.
- Standardised Questionnaires: You may be asked to complete self-assessment tools or rating scales to evaluate ADHD symptoms.
- Developmental History: Gathering information about your childhood behaviour, which may involve speaking with family members (optional).
- Additional Evaluations: In some cases, cognitive testing or screening for co-occurring conditions (e.g. anxiety, depression) may be recommended.
